

Lorry Park Rules and Regulations de Punt

General provisions:

1. Entering the Lorry Park is entirely at one's own risk. Visitors are only allowed to access those grounds and buildings that require entering in order to carry out their visitor for the performance of work and/or activities for suppliers, etc.
2. All those present drivers on the Truck parking shall be subject to a valid parking ticket, and/or a functioning as such cargo card.
3. Parking in the Lorry Park is entirely at one's own risk. Truckparkings Rotterdam Exploitatie B.V. and/or Havenbedrijf Rotterdam N.V. (hereinafter referred to as 'TRE/HBR') are not liable for any damage resulting from accident, loss, theft, or other cause in the Lorry Park. The only exception to the foregoing is if the damage was the result of an attributable and demonstrable breach of TRE/HBR or any of its employees. Any damage must be reported immediately to the Control Room on **+31 (0)88 1669699**. TRE/HBR cannot be held liable for any damage to the vehicle that is reported after leaving the Lorry Park.
4. The visitor should follow any instructions and/or directions given by or on behalf of TRE/HBR at all times. These instructions and/or directions may take the form of, inter alia, signs, instructions, or signals of staff and/or employees of servants or agents hired by TRE/HBR.
5. If the visitor fails to immediately follow the instructions and/or directions given by or on behalf of TRE/HBR, TRE/HBR accepts no liability for any damage whatsoever. (In principle, if the instructions are followed no damage can occur.)
6. TRE/HBR accepts no liability whatsoever for damage to and caused by flat tyres sustained on the grounds of the Lorry Park.
7. Staff of TRE/HBR and/or its servants or agents are at all times authorised to inspect the bags and luggage, lockers, cabin, and storage space of each vehicle and/or user.
8. If TRE/HBR or its hired help persons suffered damage because the site visitor does not comply with this regulation, Truck parking areas, the visitor is required to compensate all damages, on first reminder, without prejudice to the rights that TRE/HBR to the law can decompose.
9. It is TRE/HBR allowed to container data (IHBZ-number whether or not in combination with badge and time stamps) and images from the it system for its own purposes/statistics to use
10. If the visitor fails to comply with the rules and regulations, "TRE" may deny the visitor (permanent) access to the Truck Parking.
11. You are deemed to have agreed to these Rules and Regulations by entering the Lorry Park.

Safety instructions for visitors:

1. You are not allowed to enter the site without a valid access pass. You should have your access pass with you at all times during your stay in the Lorry Park

and show it at the request of employees of TRE/HBR and servants or agents of TRE/HBR.

2. You should park your entire vehicle in the appropriate spaces made between the lines.
3. You should park your vehicle as far back in the parking space as possible, with the back as close to the bumper as possible.
4. If you fail to follow instructions and/or directions promptly and/or correctly, TRE/HBR is entitled to move and/or remove your vehicle. TRE/HBR will recover the costs of this from you.
5. The same rules of conduct and traffic rules apply in the Lorry Park as on public roads. Road signs and signals also have the same meaning.
6. Your behaviour in the Lorry Park should not endanger and inconvenience yourself, the employees of TRE/HBR, the servants or agents of TRE/HBR, and other users of the Lorry Park. You must respect the rules of decency and etiquette observed in the Netherlands. You will be deemed to know these.
7. The design of the motor vehicles, trailers, and other means of transportation must meet legal requirements.
8. A stationary truck with trailer mounted or pendant always belongs to stand on the brakes or otherwise to be blocked, so that the vehicle does not constitute a potential danger to other traffic. The uncoupling of trailer is permitted only after explicit permission of TRE/HBR-employee, indicated on the trailer parking
9. The driver may not drive in and out of the Lorry Park and/or drive forwards or backwards unless the driver is satisfied that no danger or nuisance can arise for other traffic.
10. One can only drive a motor vehicle with a valid drivers licence on the Lorry park. Truck registration papers and driver's license are to be shown upon the request of TRE employees or hired helpers.
11. The speed limit is indicated by signs. The speed limit in the Lorry Park is 15 km/ per hour.
12. The use and/or possession of alcoholic beverages and/or drugs in the Lorry Park is prohibited.
13. Open fire is prohibited.
14. It is forbidden to smoke on a Truck parking, outside the designated spots.
15. The use of generators is prohibited.
16. Causing excessive noise is prohibited.
17. Repair and maintenance of trucks and/or commercial vehicles in the Lorry Park (this includes oil changes, etc.) is prohibited.
18. Small household waste should be deposited in the bins in the Lorry Park. Leaving behind bulky waste (tyres/pallets, etc.) is prohibited. Minor chemical waste (batteries, etc.) should be handed in to the property manager.
19. Placing objects, obstacles, and/or barriers on the road is prohibited without prior authorisation from the security company and/or TRE/HBR.
20. It is forbidden to enter the Truck parking with cars, bicycles, mopeds, motorcycles and/or scooters to enter.
21. Passenger cars of TRE staff and service vehicles may only be parked in the

- designated parking spaces in the Lorry Park.
22. It is forbidden to Coaches on the Truck parking to park.
 23. Cooling generators may only be operated via electric reefer terminals.
 24. Reefer spots may only be used by other visitors if there are no other places are available and/or on indication of TRE/HBR.
 25. The Lorry park is accessible for cargo containing certain hazardous substances or ADR goods. Dedicated ADR-parking place will be assigned upon entry and one is obliged to provide accurate information (UN code) regarding these goods to the parking operator.
 26. One is obliged to park at the entrance assigned parking spot.
 27. Minor may only if accompanied by an adult on the Truck parking walk or in the plumbing unit.

Available services:

The Lorry Park is open 365 days a year, 24 hours a day.
The following facilities are available in the Lorry Park:

- AED device, is located at the building
- Toilets
- Showers (fee required)
- Washer/dryer (fee required)
- Reefers (fee required)
- Wi-Fi
- Lounge
- TV

Access regulations:

1. You may enter the Lorry Park with a valid access pass only. A valid pass is either a printed personal parking ticket provided on entry, or a valid Cargo Card that is functioning as such. A valid pass can not be transferred to other individuals in order for them to enter or exit the Lorry Park.
2. HBR, TRE, and servants, agents or employees hired by TRE/HBR are responsible for monitoring the implementation and enforcement of these regulations. HBR, TRE, and servants or agents hired by TRE/HBR are authorised to derogate temporarily from the provisions contained in these regulations.
3. Without prejudice to any steps that can be taken with regard to offenders in breach of or who act contrary to any provisions of these regulations, such persons may also be prohibited from entering the Lorry Park with any vehicle.

Parking chassis:

1. Chassis may only be parked if they are connected to the vehicle.
2. Disconnecting chassis is prohibited in connection with possible damage to the

asphalt.

3. The parking of chassis without a vehicle is only and only allowed on designated spots and with explicit permission of TRE/HBR.

Final provisions:

1. All matters not provided for by these Lorry Park Rules and Regulations will be decided by our employees or the employees of the security company.
2. The invalidity of any clause in these Lorry Park Rules and Regulations will not affect the validity of any of the other clauses.
3. We wish you a pleasant stay in our Lorry Park and assume that these Lorry Park Rules and Regulations will contribute to this.
